Newsome Park Elementary

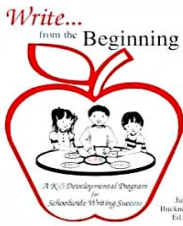
- Newsome Park is a Title I school located in Newport News, Virginia

- Newsome Park is a K-5 Math, Science, and Technology magnet school.
- Has approximately 750 K-5 students
- Utilizes “looping” technique, where students remain with same teacher for two years, e.g., K-1, 2-3, and 4-5
- Received the Newport News Public Schools SOL Gold Award for having improved in all content areas of the SOL in third and fifth grades
- Recognized as a Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration (CSR/D) site by the federal government
- Highlighted by the George Lucas Educational Foundation (www.glef.org) for innovative teaching strategies
- In addition to Thinking Maps® and *Write...from the Beginning*, faculty is trained in technology integration, constructivist math, SOAR, mentoring, character education, and service learning.

Florida – Brookshire Elementary

Mississippi – Greenwood Public Schools

Greenwood Public Schools implemented *Write...from the Beginning* in November 1999. On the writing portion of the 2001 Mississippi Curriculum test, 94% of the district’s 327 fourth-graders earned passing scores. Statewide, the passage rate was 87% for fourth-graders.

Virginia – Newsome Park Elementary School

As indicated above, Newsome Park Elementary is a Title I magnet school located in Newport News, Virginia. Thinking Maps® were implemented in 1997-1998 and *Write...from the Beginning* was introduced in 1999-2000. The school has been cited for many honors, including the Newport News Public Schools SOL Gold Award for having improved in all content areas of the Virginia Standards of Learning in third and fifth grades, identification as a Comprehensive School Reform Demonstration (CSRD) site by the federal government, and recognition by the George Lucas Educational Foundation (www.glef.org) for innovative teaching strategies.
